

IATA Transportation of Power Sonic Sealed Lead-Acid Batteries

Air shipment not restricted, as per special provision A67

After consultation with the **DANGEROUS GOODS OFFICE** of the **CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY**, **POWER SONIC BATTERIES** can be transported according to PI 872 and according to A67 as not restricted (IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations).

The CLASSIFICATION for this type of battery is UN2800 BATTERIES WET, NON-SPILLABLE, electric storage.

POWER SONIC BATTERIES COMPLY IN FULL WITH SPECIAL PROVISION A67 which applies to this classification and states that:

NON-SPILLABLE BATTERIES are **NOT RESTRICTED** for at a Temperature of 55°C (130°F) the electrolyte will not flow from a ruptured or cracked case and there is no free liquid to flow, and if, when packed for transport, the terminals are protected from short circuit.
